**Report on the Audit of Consolidated Financial Results**

**Opinion**

We have audited the accompanying Consolidated Quarterly and annual financial results ("the statement") of AB COTSPIN INDIA LIMITED "the Parent" and its subsidiaries together referred to as "the group" for the Quarter and year ended March 31, 2025 "attached herewith, being submitted by the Parent pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015. as amended ("Listing Regulations").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, and based on the consideration of the audit reports, on separate financial statements of the subsidiaries, the Consolidated Financial Results for the Quarter and year ended March 31, 2025:

**Basis for Opinion**

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (SAs) specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act"). Our responsibilities under those Standards are further described in the "Auditor's Responsibilities for the audit of



the Consolidated Financial Results" section of our report. We are independent of the Group in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India together with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the Consolidated financial statement under the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Rules thereunder, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements and the Code of Ethics. We believe that the audit evidence obtained by us is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

### **Managements and Board of Directors' Responsibilities for the Consolidated Quarterly and Annual Financial Results**

These Consolidated Quarterly and Annual financial results have been prepared on the basis of the Consolidated Annual financial statements.

The Parent Company's Management and Board of Directors are responsible for the preparation of these Consolidated Quarterly and annual financial results that give a true and fair view of the Consolidated net profit and Consolidated other comprehensive income and other financial information of the Group in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard prescribed under Section 133 of the Act read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations.

This responsibility of the respective Board of Directors of the Company included in the Group also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of the Group and for preventing and detecting Frauds and other irregularities: selection and application of appropriate accounting policies making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent, and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the Consolidated Quarterly and annual financial results that give true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the Consolidated Quarterly and annual financial results, the Respective management and Board of Directors are responsible for the assessing the Group ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the Respective management and Board of Directors either intend to liquidate the company or to cease operations, or have no realistic alternative but to do so.

The Respective Board of Directors are also responsible for overseeing the Group financial reporting process.

### **Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Consolidated Financial Results**



The objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Consolidated financial results as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with SAs will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatement can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decision of users taken on the basis of the Consolidated financial results.

As part of an audit in accordance with SAs, we exercise professional judgement and maintain professional scepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the Consolidated financial results, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentation, or the override of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate to the circumstances. Under Section 143(3)(i) of the companies Act 2013, we are also responsible for expressing our opinion through a separate report on the complete set of financial statements on whether the company has adequate internal financial controls with reference to financial statements in place and the operating effectiveness of such controls.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by the Management and Board of Directors.
- Conclude on the appropriateness of the Management and Board of Directors use of the going concern basis of accounting and based on the audit evidence obtained, whether a material uncertainty exists related to events and conditions that may cast significant doubt on the company's ability to continue as a going concern. If we conclude that material uncertainty exists, we are required to draw attention in our auditor's report to related disclosures in the Consolidated financial results or, if such disclosures are inadequate to modify our opinion. Our conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of our auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the Group to cease to continue as a going concern.
- Evaluate the overall presentation structure and content of the Consolidated financial results including the disclosures, and whether the Consolidated financial results represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair representation.
- Obtain sufficient appropriate audit evidence regarding the financial statements/ financial information to express an opinion on the Consolidated financial statements.



Materiality is the magnitude of misstatements in the Annual Consolidated Financial Results that, individually or in aggregate, makes it probable that the economic decisions of a reasonably knowledgeable user of the Annual Consolidated Financial Results may be influenced. We consider quantitative materiality and qualitative factors in (i) planning the scope of our audit work and in evaluating the results of our work; and (ii) to evaluate the effect of any identified misstatements in the Annual Consolidated Financial Results.

We communicate with those charge with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.

We also provide those charged with governance with a statement that we have complied with relevant ethical requirements regarding independence, and to communicate with them all relationships and other matters that may reasonable be thought to bear on our independence and where applicable related safeguards.

### Other Matters

- a. The statement includes the Consolidated results for the Quarterly ended March 31,2025, being the balancing figure between audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the management certified unaudited year to date figures up to the third quarter of the current financial year, which were subjected to a limited review by us, as required under Listing Regulations.
- b. The Consolidated annual financial results dealt with by this report has been prepared for the express purpose of filing with the Stock Exchange. These results are based on and should be read with the audited Consolidated annual financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2025 on which we issued our audit report dated 26<sup>th</sup> May 2025.

## NOTES TO CONSOLIDATED FINANCIAL RESULTS:

- 1 The financial results of A B Cotspin India Limited ("the Company") for the Quarterly and Year Ended March 31, 2025 has been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their respective meetings held on 26th May, 2025.
- 2 The above Consolidated financial results have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles of applicable Indian Accounting Standards ('Ind AS'), as notified under the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (as amended), specified under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with the presentation and disclosure requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements), 2015 as amended.
- 3 Pursuant to the resolution passed by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on August 25, 2023, the Company approved the issuance and allotment of 1,20,28,562 Fully Convertible Warrants on a preferential basis to persons belonging to the 'Promoter & Promoter Group' and the 'non-promoter' category, at an issue price of ₹70/ per warrant. This issuance was made in accordance with the provisions of Chapter V of the SEBI (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations and aggregates to a total amount of up to ₹84,19,99,340/-.  
The aforesaid issuance was subsequently approved by the shareholders at the Annual General Meeting held on September 25, 2023.  
Further, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter V of the SEBI ICDR Regulations, the Company has converted 61,27,140 warrants into equity shares in three tranches, on March 5, 2025, March 12, 2025, and March 17, 2025, respectively, in favor of the respective allottees till 31st March, 2025.
- 4 In line with Ind AS -108 Operating Segments and basis of the review of operations being done by the Senior Management, the operations of the Company fall under the Cotton ginning and netting business which is considered to be the only reportable segment by the management.
- 5 The figures of the Quarter ended March 31, 2025 are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of the Full Financial Year and the published year to date figures upto third quarter of the current financial year
- 6 Previous year figures have been regrouped/ rearranged wherever necessary to correspond with the current year's classification/ disclosures.

- 2 The above standalone financial results have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles of applicable Indian Accounting Standards ("Ind AS"), as notified under the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (as amended), specified under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with the presentation and disclosure requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements), 2015 as amended.
- 3 Pursuant to the resolution passed by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on August 25, 2023, the Company approved the issuance and allotment of 1,20,28,562 Fully Convertible Warrants on a preferential basis to persons belonging to the 'Promoter & Promoter Group' and the 'non-promoter' category, at an issue price of ₹70/- per warrant. This issuance was made in accordance with the provisions of Chapter V of the SEBI (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations and aggregates to a total amount of up to ₹84,19,99,340/-.
- 4 The aforesaid issuance was subsequently approved by the shareholders at the Annual General Meeting held on September 25, 2023.
